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Fiddle Block Set

INCLUDED: Fiddle Blocks (one with cleat and one without), 50 feet of line with eye splice on one end, (1) Tenex prusik, (2) carabiners (link on smaller versions) to attach prusik to upper block.

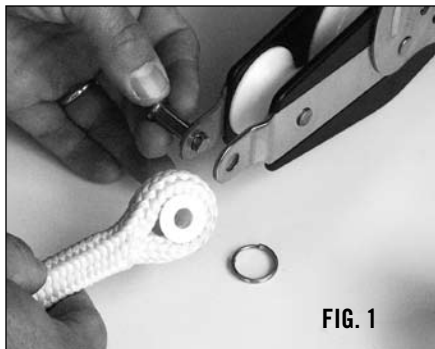

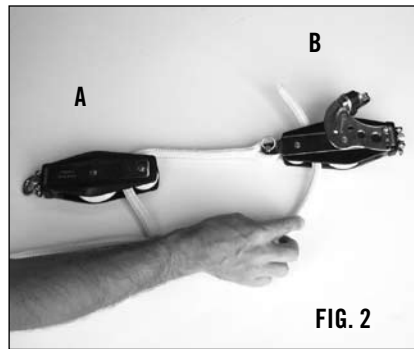

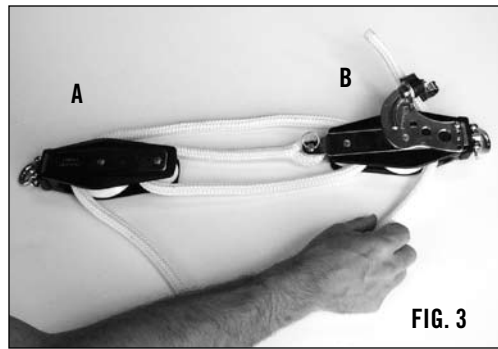

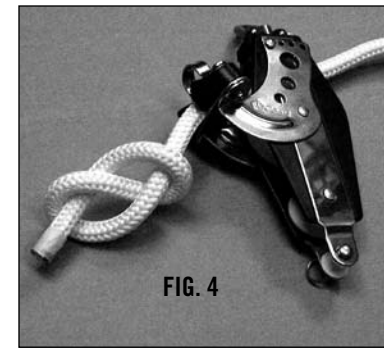

1. (FIG. 1) Insert the small bushing into the rope eye, attach bushing to block using pin and secure using split ring.
2. (FIG. 2) Thread the end of the line through small sheave on block A, followed by block B.
3. (FIG. 3) Thread the end of the line through A blocks large sheave, followed by block B exiting through the cleat.
4. (FIG. 4) Tie a figure of eight in the end of the line to keep it from backing out of the cleat.
5. (FIG. 5) Attach the prusik to the B block using the provided link. The system is now ready for use.
6. (FIG 6) To use the Fiddle block set first attach the PRUSIK to the line to be tensioned. Next attach the lower block to a secure anchor point. You are now ready to pull tension on the exiting line being careful not to exceed the block or any other object in the systems strength capacity. Each stride of pull can be held in place with the cleat of the upper Fiddle block but keep in mind that this cleat is the weakest part of the Fiddle block set. To release your line from the cleat you can flip it out with a crisp arm-whipping action but **WARNING!!** Keep your hands 3 or more feet back from the cleat to avoid having fingers sucked into this potentially dangerous area.
7. (FIG. 6) The Fiddle block set is best stored by folding the four parts of line into a neat bundle, tying that with an overhand knot and stuffing it into a clean dry bag.

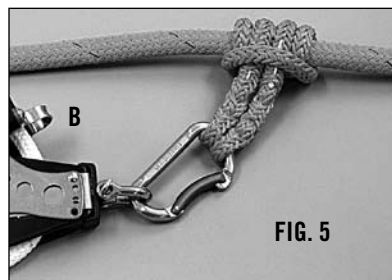

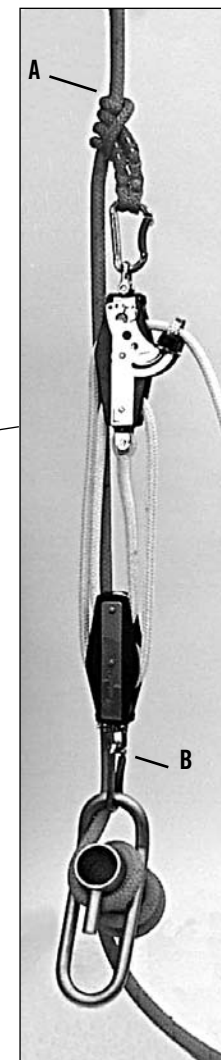

a-wrap III.

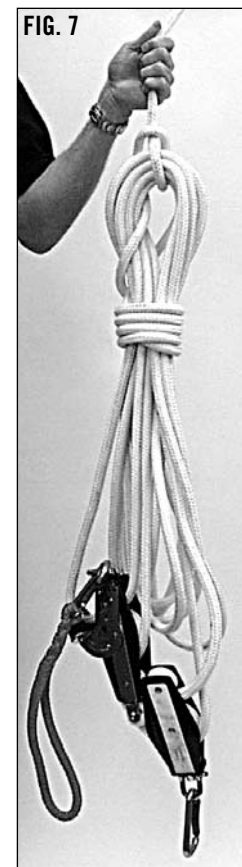
